- Always take bottles with enough drinking water.
- First aid kit. When it occurs more often: sticking plaster to treat blisters.
- Personal medications.
- Raincoat with hood or a cap.
- General weatherproof clothing. If you hike in winter make sure to take gloves and warm clothes.
- Some extra clothes just in case, if you need to change during a tour.
- Pocket knife or cutlery for a snack lunch.
- Headlamp or flashlight
- Sunglasses, sunscreen and a hat.
- Slippers for the stay in the accommodation.
- Swimwear.
- Camera.
- Some cash if you visit a tavern or a restaurant on your way.
- Field glasses only optional.
